**Rossall Won by 4 Wkts:**

Man of the Match: Anug Neog

Summary: The 1<sup>st</sup> XI put LRGS in gloomy conditions and the home team struggled to cope with Toby Lester (2-19) and Phil Rimmer (2-16). Superb fielding from Arzaman Baroowa and Christoph Gaete along with a fine spell of spin bowling from Sid Bhuyan (3-31) resulted in LRGS being bowled out for 142. In reply Luke Williams (42) and Anug Neog put on 86 for the first wicket as the 1<sup>st</sup> XI made light work of the modest total set for victory. However too many soft dismissals towards the end of the game meant the end result was closer than it should have been.

*2<sup>nd</sup> XI Vs LRGS (Rossall 96-8, LRGS 99-7 – Lost by 3 wickets)*

The 2<sup>nd</sup> XI eventually lost with 5 balls to spare but in the end 96 was never going to be enough on the Anchor field. Toby Holder-Williams top scored with (23) and was supported well by Louis Weir (19). In the field the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI were pleasingly competitive with Jack Morrison (2-9) and Frazer Forster (2-14) the pick of the bowlers. Toby Holder-Williams was man of the match for his captain's innings.

*U15 XI Vs LRGS (Rossall 141-7, LRGS 101 all out – Won by 40 runs)*

The U15's won easily at LRGS having set the opposition a modest total of 141 to chase – Cameron Ronson (47) and Louis Weir top (41) top scored. In reply left arm spinner Harrison Talbot took 4-16 and Jack Morrison 2-21 as the U15's dismissed Lancaster for 101 – a good win

*U14 XI Vs LRGS (Rossall 116-6, LRGS 114 all out – Won by 2 runs)*

Joshua Williams again enjoyed the LRGS bowling attack this time scoring an unbeaten 31 at home and along with Will Waterton (24\*) took the U14 total past 100 in this 25 over match. In reply Harry Mawer took 2-9 and Weaver 2-15 as Rossall had LRGS in trouble at 90-7. However a terrific spell of swing bowling from Harley Taylor 4-11 helped the U14's win with 4 balls to spare and by 2 runs.

*U13 XI Vs LRGS (Rossall 70 all out, LRGS 72-2 – Lost by 8 Wickets)*

Lancaster outplayed the U13's on their own patch, dismissing them for 70 inside 25 overs. Tom Morrison and Harry Andrews picked up the two wickets but LRGS won with 5 overs to spare and by 8 wickets. It was good to see Hermes Elias play and score his first runs for Rossall – great news!

*U12 XI Vs LRGS (LRGS 80 all out, Rossall 81-6 – Won by 4 Wickets)*

James Boyd in his first game as captain won the toss and decided to let the visitors bat first.

Lancaster were all out for 80 runs - Boyd (4 for 17), Eastham (3 for 10), Evans (1 for 2), Braidford (1 for 5) & Lee (1 for 16) & Hawley-Evans (0 for 21).

Rossall went into bat with Stonier and Evans opening. Lancaster bowled well and before we knew it Rossall required 27 runs to win with 4 wickets left. Boyd & Eastham batted superbly and won it for Rossall. Rossall finished 81 for 6.
