The child's full name and address should be fixed inside their trunk and suitcase/holdall and trunks should be clearly marked on the outside underneath the lock.

To assist the Needle room and Laundry and to reduce the risk of loss, please note the following points carefully.

All articles of clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name. It is essential that they are named in a convenient place for example just below the neckband of a skirt and at the top of socks. All shoes and boots should also be clearly marked. A glued in name tape is ideal. All sports must be looped for hanging.

All name tapes should be the largest lettering available and a reserve supply of a dozen tapes should be sent in the trunk when they first enter School. The name tape should show the initials and the name of the boy and then the code for Anchor. e.g. A.B. Smith – A

All items of clothing should be capable of being machine washed and tumble dried. Please note that a charge will be made for items which have to be dry-cleaned.

Home clothes (informal dress) must not be flamboyant or ostentatious and, a storage space is limited **NO MORE THAN 3 CASUAL OUTSITS** must be brought to School Delicate/ designer or very costly items should be avoided.

No jewellery other than a wristwatch, which must be engraved on the back with the owner's name, may be worn, except for religious reasons. Wearers of watches must be able to tell the time.

Hair must be kept short for the sake of hygiene. Hair wax and hair gel must not be worn.
